

Bridge Lessons: Learn to Defend

What:

Bridge players spend 25% of their time as declarer, 25% of their time as "dummy," and 50% of their time as a defender. Because we spend twice as much time defending as we do playing a hand, strong defensive skills are essential to success.

Cheryl Haines and Maria Grigorieff will teach a series of nine lessons using the ACBL (American Contract Bridge League) book, "Defense in the 21st Century," second edition. Nine topics will be covered in in nine weekly lessons. Topics include:

- Opening leads against notrump contracts
- o Opening leads against suit contracts
- o Third hand play
- o Second hand play
- o Defensive signals
- Developing defensive tricks
- o Interfering with declarer
- o Making a plan
- Preemptive bidding and responses

A Better Mousetrap

This is a series of lessons designed to enhance your competitive edge, whether playing at a club or tournaments. All classes are hands-on with relevant practice deals.

1. Review of Basic Competitive Bidding

This is the "bread and butter" issue. You have to get this right and have a clear understanding with your partner.

Two 21/2-hour sessions: Mondays, October 14, October 21, 2019

2. Competitive Doubles

Doubles are economical bids, conveying clear messages without taking up bidding room. Negative Double and Support Double are essential tools in your bidding toolkit.

Two 2½-hour sessions: Thursdays, October 17, October 24, 2019

3. Useful Conventions

a. Two-Way Checkback

This is an improved version of New Minor Forcing. It shows more clarity and definition in the responses.

One 21/2-hour session: Monday, October 28, 2019

b. Four-Suit Transfers

We have been taught to always try to play 3NT rather than a game in a minor suit. This makes it difficult to get to a minor suit slam. Four-Suit Transfers help you find your slam in a minor.
