

Our annual unit meeting took place on December 11 at the Villa. Forty-four members attended in person, plus another six via Zoom. The membership approved our treasurer's report, which showed a current balance of \$34,462.11. This is slightly above our average for the past few years and puts us in good condition to begin 2022. We also elected three new directors to two-year terms, and Danna Sorenson to a second term.

A unit game followed our meeting, and at 12 tables, was the largest played live at the Villa in 2021. Winners in the NS section of the 8-table open game, and first overall were Loretta Baines & Carole Ringoen (60.3%), followed by Roger Dewes & Dariush Youssefi (59.5%). In the EW section, first and second finishers were also separated by less than 1% - Aster Wu & Stan Chow (56.4%) and Siuling Ku & Kenneth Hui (55.6%). In the 4-table 499er game, Jeanie Kwong & Susan Hall (65.6%) took first place, and Kai Eckert & Becca Simmons (58.2%) were second, just ahead of Marie Pattie & Jeanne Urich (57.4%). Thanks to Jennifer Kuhn for directing these games.

We will not host a sectional tournament in February 2022. Our preferred location, Cañada College, is still closed for events sponsored by external organizations. We plan to hold a sectional on August 13 & 14, however; and will look for an alternative site if Cañada has not opened by the time needed to plan the tournament. We also plan to resume NLM sectionals in 2022 on May 7 and October 29 at the Villa. Players with fewer than 750 masterpoints and ranks below Life Master are eligible to play in the NLM sectionals.
